"We entered Economy and our surprises grew," reported a visitor to the home of the religious and communal Harmony Society in 1831. Visitors today are just as surprised.

The Harmonists, of German heritage, lived a lifestyle where work and wealth were shared. Their work ethic was evident in the remarkable successes in textile manufacturing, agriculture, and investments in coal, oil, and railroads. Their legacy is found in their architecture, gardens, music, and craftsmanship, as well as their gifts to charities in America and abroad.

The site contains seventeen buildings furnished with thousands of original objects purchased or made by the Harmony Society. The Society's 1827 Natural History Museum, large Feast Hall, and founder George Rapp's impressive house and formal gardens, are just a few of the site's many unique highlights.

Old Economy Village is administered by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission in partnership with the Friends of Old Economy Village.
